Seed Giveaway Day Report

Intended Plan:

- School assembly with smoothie bike to be done on 22nd March to prepare kids for the seed packets they will get before easter holidays.
- All seeds and leaflets to be given out on 24th March 2016 to all pupils in the school (date chosen by the school)
- Kids will start to grow their seeds at home over the easter holidays.





Actual Results:

 Schoool assembly with smoothie bike (fruit donated by Alan Bale), completed on 22nd March 2016. School had restrictions on the smoothie bike and only one child was allowed to try it out and one child from each class was allowed to drink the smoothies to prevent allergy confusion.

Kids reacted well to the assembly and got very excited about the project.

Seeds were not given out on the 24th March 2016 as the school ran out of time also having arranged two other activities for the same day. The school then gave out the seeds to all pupils over the course of 11th April and 12th April after the easter holidays along with the leaflets. This meant that the date on the leaflets was incorrect.

Kids reacted well to the seed handout and parents referred to it as "the great seed giveaway". Kids were excited about the seeds they got and were keen to tell everyone which plant they were going to grow.
